Proposed Constitutional Changes - 2012 Summary

- 1. Increases terms for Officers from 1 to 3 years and sets term limits at two consecutive terms. Terms are staggered to provide continuity.
- 2. Requires an officer to be off the Board for three years prior to running for any office or Board position.
- 3. Requires an officer to have Board experience.
- 4. Requires officers to pay full dues regardless of age since Officers vote on dues, etc.
- 5. Adds purpose.
- 6. Changes the title Executive Committee to Board of Directors (Board)
- 7. Fixes error in current Constitution dating to 2007 when Board terms were increased to 3 years.
- 8. Changes appointment of Nominating Committee from President to Board (consistent with Robert's Rules of Order)
- 9. Change in wording only.
- 10. Allows the Nominating Committee to nominate more than 4 members for the Board
- 11. Removes duties of Recording Secretary and makes the Secretary/Treasurer the Corresponding Secretary.
- 12. Requires the Board (instead of President, VP or Board) to approve non-routine expenditures.
- 13. Adds Recording Secretary appointed by Board.
- 14. Requires the Board to assure that bookkeeping is maintained according to GAAP standards.
- 15. Adds policy for filling the vacancy of any Board position (including officers)
- 16. Changes wording related to Board members missing meetings.
- 17. Allows the Board and Committees to vote by e-mail (consistent with Robert's Rules of Order). A policy will be established.
- 18. Sets a quorum for Board Meetings. A quorum is not mentioned in the current Constitution, so by law a simple majority is all that is required for quorum.
- 19, 21 & 22. Information on the Membership Committee is currently found in three separate Sections. Moves all Membership Committee information to one Article/Section. Changes in wording only.
- 20. Allows the Board to remove a member after a single occurrence if it is serious enough.
- 23. Allows the President to call a Special meeting to vote on dues and/or initiation fees.
- 24. Increases initiation fees for new members to \$10,000 while keeping the initiation fees for sons and daughters who join before their 24th birthday or marriage the same.
- 25. Increases notice for Constitutional changes from 10 to 30 days.
- 26. Requires that the Annual Meeting be held any time before February 28.
- 27. Requires 30 days notice of Annual meetings.
- 28. Change in wording only.
- 29. Requires 30 days notice of Special meetings.
- 30. Allows Seasonal Members to attend Board and Committee meetings but not the Annual meeting or Special meetings.
- 31. Allows Seasonal Members to serve on certain Standing Committees.
